

## Entegris Announces Plans to Build New Manufacturing Center of Excellence in Colorado Springs

New facility expands U.S. footprint and support to strategic customers in the United States

## AT A GLANCE<sup>1</sup>

Initially supports production for Advanced Materials Handling (AMH) and Microcontamination Control (MC) divisions, which develop critical products used to manufacture semiconductors

Targeted to begin initial commercial operations in early 2025

Approximately \$600M to be invested in construction of facility over several years

New campus to be built in phases, with 100,000 sq. ft in initial phase

Potential to create approximately 600 new jobs over several years, doubling Entegris' presence in Colorado, with potential to continue to expand over time

Supported by state and local incentives

New facility to include advanced environmental sustainability features

Constructed and operated in alignment with 4 pillars of Entegris' Corporate Social Responsibility framework: Innovation, Safety, Personal Development and Inclusion, and Sustainability
